




## 1. Setup device

### **Option 1**

If you are going to be using a SIM card to provide Wi-Fi throughout your boat you will need to insert your sim card now. You can find the Micro Sim slot on the bottom of the router. Then attach the 'Antennas'.




### **Option 2**

## 2. Power ON

### Step 1



Now power ON your device, you will need to use the micro USB to Universal power adapter provided. You will know the device is ON once the 'Power indicator' Led lights up blue.

## 3. Connecting to Wi-Fi

### Step 1

Once your device is ON use your phone to check for available Wi-Fi networks, there should now be a Wi-Fi network labeled YS\_Marina\_XXXX. Connect to this network the password should be stuck on below.

### Step 2

If you inserted a SIM card into your unit then you should now be up and running. You can skip to the 'Test' section of the quide on page '9'.

## 4. Extend your Wi-Fi network

If you want to extend your current Wi-Fi network instead of using a SIM card, follow these steps.

### Step 1

Open your browser and type in **192.168.10.1**, you will then be asked to enter the password. The password is 'admin'.



### Step 2

Now on the top lefthand corner you need to click on **Wizard** and then select **Bridge**.



### Step 3

On the 'Repeater Settings' page, you will need to connect to your current Wi-Fi network to establish a connection between the two devices. Click on 'Scan Band' and select 2.4GHz, then click Scan. You should then see a list of active Wi-Fi networks around you. Select the one you want to bridge a connection between and enter the password.

Once this is complete click 'Next'.



### Step 4

Now create a new access point name and password.



### Step 5

You should now be on the 'Wi-Fi 5.8G', ignore this page and click next.

### Step 6

Finally, confirm the name of your new Wi-Fi network and click 'Finish'. Your device will then restart, after the restart is complete your network should be up and running.



## 5. Test

### Step 1

To test if your internet connection is up and running, connect to your Wi-Fi network as normal and visit www.yacht-sentinel.com. If you have followed the steps correctly the website should load without any issue, if you are still experiencing problems, visit our website and talk to us over live chat or check out our FAO's page.
